WEC Energy Group Supplier Code of Conduct

We expect you, as our business partner and supplier, to commit to conducting all business on our behalf in a manner consistent with the values and clear expectations stated in the WEC Energy Group Code of Business Conduct. In support of this, you must abide by the following principles, as further defined in our contract terms and conditions.

- Safety Suppliers must promote a safe work environment at all times. This includes
 watching for, taking immediate action to address and reporting unsafe conditions; ensuring
 contract workers are trained and knowledgeable on safety guidelines and procedures; and
 ensuring contract workers are free from the effects of alcohol and other drugs.
- Ethics and compliance Suppliers must abide by all aspects of Laws, as defined in our contract terms and conditions, including the spirit of such Laws. This requirement includes all applicable employment laws and regulations regarding forced or compulsory labor, child labor, working hours, payment of wages, and the protection of freedom of association.
 Suppliers must report known or suspected violations of Laws and other unethical behaviors as they relate to work associated with our company to the appropriate company contact.
- Workplace conduct Suppliers must ensure a work environment free from harassing, intimidating, threatening and discriminatory behaviors, and refrain from conduct that is or could appear to be a conflict of interest, thus jeopardizing the integrity of our company.
- Protection and use of assets Suppliers must ensure protection of confidential and
 proprietary WEC Energy Group information, ensure disclosure of such information is only on a
 need-to-know basis and when properly authorized or legally required, and ensure any use of
 WEC Energy Group tangible and intangible assets is done so in the manner in which the asset
 was designed and intended.
- Financial discipline Suppliers must ensure accurate, timely, complete and
 understandable financial and operating records that apply to work performed for our
 company. Such records must be in compliance with applicable accounting and securities
 principles, laws, rules, and regulations.
- Fair competition and fair dealing Suppliers must refrain from behaviors that could, for example, restrain competition, result in the exchange of competitive information, fix prices, rig bids or allocate markets.
- Supplier diversity WEC Energy Group is committed to building meaningful business
 opportunities for certified minority-, women-, service-disabled- and veteran-owned businesses.
 Suppliers are expected to support the WEC Energy Group supplier diversity initiative and
